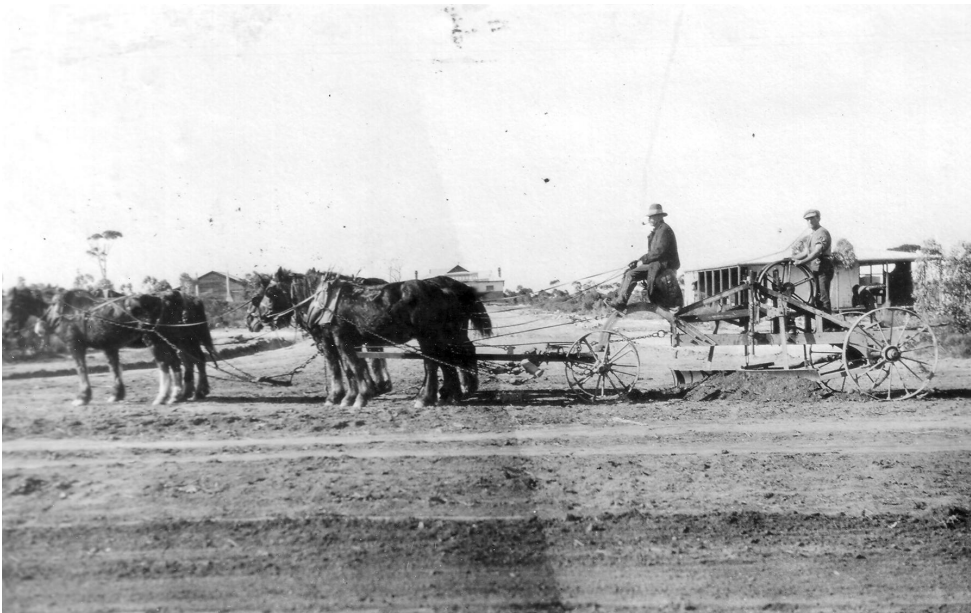

Hot Coals - Please don't dump hot coals at the rubbish tip or in your rubbish bins. These can start a fire with a little wind.

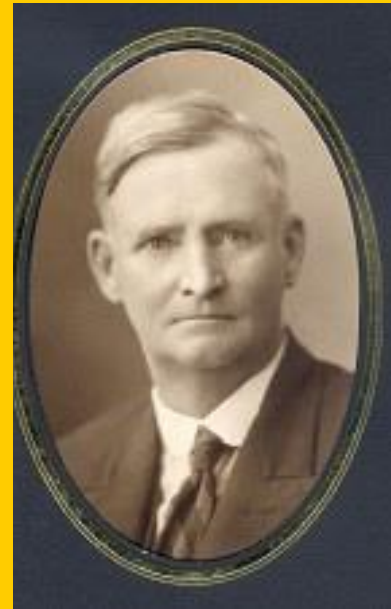

GOVERNMENT GRANT – LOCAL ROADS AND COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM (LRCI)

The Shire of Wyalkatchem has accepted the offer of a grant for \$320,734 (exclusive of GST) from the Australian Government.

The LRCI Program aims to assist a community-led recovery from COVID-19 by supporting local jobs, firms, and procurement. It is expected councils, where possible, will use local businesses and workforces to deliver projects under the LRCI Program to ensure stimulus funding flows into local communities. Program guidelines can be accessed through the Department's website at www.investment.infrastructure.gov.au/lrci

The intended outcomes of the LRCI Program are to:

- provide stimulus to protect and create local short-term employment opportunities through funded projects following the impacts of COVID-19; and
- deliver benefits to communities, such as improved road safety, accessibility and visual amenity.
